Exodus, Chapter 6

² God spoke to Moses and said to him, “I am Adonai. ³ I appeared to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob as El Shaddai, but I did not make Myself known to them by My name, Adonai. ⁴ I also established My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land in which they lived. ⁵ I have now heard the moaning of the Israelites, whom the Egyptians are enslaving, whom the Egyptians are enslaving, and I have remembered My covenant.

⁶ Say, therefore, to the Israelite people: I am Adonai. I will bring you out from your enslavement to the Egyptians, I will rescue you from the hard labor they impose, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. ⁷ I will take you to myself for a people, and I will be your God. Then you will know that I am Adonai your God, who brought you out from your enslavement to the Egyptians. ⁸ I will bring you to the land I swore to give to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob—and I will give it to you as a possession. I am Adonai!”

⁹ Moses told this to the Israelites, but they did not listen to him because of their discouragement and hard labor. ¹⁰ Then Adonai said to Moses, ¹¹ “Go, tell Pharaoh king of Egypt that he must release the Israelites from his land.” ¹² But Moses replied to God, “If the Israelites did not listen to me, then how will Pharaoh listen to me, since I speak with difficulty?” ¹³ Adonai spoke to Moses and Aaron and gave them a command for the children of Israel, and for Pharaoh, king of Egypt, to bring the Israelites out of the land of Egypt.

Ezekiel, Chapter 28

²⁵ Thus says Adonai: When I gather the house of Israel from the peoples among whom they are scattered and display My holiness in them in the sight of the nations, then they shall dwell in their land that I have given to My servant Jacob. ²⁶ They shall dwell safely in it and shall build houses and plant vineyards and dwell securely when I execute judgments on all those around them who despise them. Then they shall know that I am Adonai their God.
