FINAL BENEDICTION

Genesis 9:8-19

8 God then said to Noah and his sons who were with him, 9 “As for Me, I am going to establish My covenant with you and with your descendants after you,10 and with every living being in your care - the birds, the beasts, and all the land animals in your care - all who have gone out of the ark, all earth’s animals. 11 I am establishing My covenant with you; never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood; never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth.”12 And God said, “Here is the sign I am giving you of the covenant between Me and you, and every living being with you, down to the last generation: 13 I have placed My bow in the cloud - it will be a sign of the covenant between Me and the earth. 14 And when I cause clouds to form over the earth, and the bow appears in the clouds, 15 I will remember My covenant between Me and you and all living beings, all flesh, and never again shall the waters become a flood, to destroy all flesh. 16 When the bow is in the cloud, and I see it, I will remember the everlasting covenant between God and all living beings, all that live upon the earth.” 17 And God said to Noah, “This is the sign of the covenant that I have established, between Me and all that live upon the earth.” 18 And Noah’s sons, who went out of the ark, were Shem, Ham and Japheth. And Ham - he was the father of Canaan. 19 These three were Noah’s sons; from these the whole earth was populated.

Isaiah 54: 7 – 10

7 For a brief moment I forsook you; with abiding love, I take you back. 8 In a moment of flooding anger I hid My face from you, but now, with love unending, I take you in, says your Redeemer, Adonai. 9 This is like the days of Noah to Me - I promised then never again to cover the earth with the waters of Noah’s days. So now I promise never again to be angry with you or rebuke you. 10 Though the mountains may depart and the hills be removed, My love shall never depart from you, and My covenant of peace shall not be removed, says the One who loves you, Adonai.
