Exodus: Chapter 26

¹ Then God said to Moses, “Come up to Adonai, you, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and you shall worship from a distance. ² Moses alone shall come near Adonai, but they shall not come near, nor may the people go up with him.”

³ Moses came and told the people all the words of Adonai and all the laws. Then all the people answered with one voice and said, “All the words which Adonai has said, we will do.” ⁴ Moses wrote down all the words of Adonai, and rose up early in the morning, and built an altar at the foot of the mountain with twelve pillars for the twelve tribes of Israel. ⁵ He sent young Israelite men who offered burnt offerings and sacrificed peace offerings of young bulls to Adonai. ⁶ Moses took half of the blood and put it in basins, and half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. ⁷ He took the Book of the Covenant and read in the hearing of the people, and they said, “All that Adonai has said we will do, and we will be obedient.”

⁸ So Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, “This is the blood of the covenant, which Adonai has made with you in accordance with all these words.”

⁹ Then Moses went up with Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, ¹⁰ and they saw the God of Israel, and under God’s feet there was something like a paved work of sapphire stone as clear as the sky itself. ¹¹ Adonai did not lay God’s hand upon the nobles of the children of Israel. They saw God, and they ate, and they drank.

I Kings, Chapter 6

¹⁰ Solomon built the storied annex all around the Temple, each story five cubits high; they were held fast to the Temple by beams of cedar. ¹¹ Then the word of the Lord came to Solomon: ¹² “Concerning this Temple that you have been building I tell you this: if you obey My statutes and carry out My rules of justice and take care to keep all My commandments, I will fulfill My promise, the one I made to your father, David, ¹³ and I will dwell among the people of Israel and never forsake My people Israel.”
